**Shoe Box Update** - There were 700,474 boxes sent from Canada plus an extra 23,000 boxes and 56,000 cartons of clothes were sent to Ukraine. 77,283 decisions were made for Jesus by children from these interactions. Between 2009 and 2014 there have been 2,122,698 confessions of faith, 39,000 Canadian volunteers and 67,550 North American children have committed to pray for non Christian friends.
