Due to hyperinflation, collapse of public services, virtually absent rule of law and severe restrictions to get food, medicine and other basic supplies almost one million Venezuelan refugees have crossed the border into Columbia, especially in the region where we live (northern border). On August 21st an earthquake hit Venezuela adding to the challenges that people are facing. Please pray for the people who are forced to leave their homes due to the difficult conditions the country is going through. Pray for their peace and protection as well as the provision of food and medicines.
