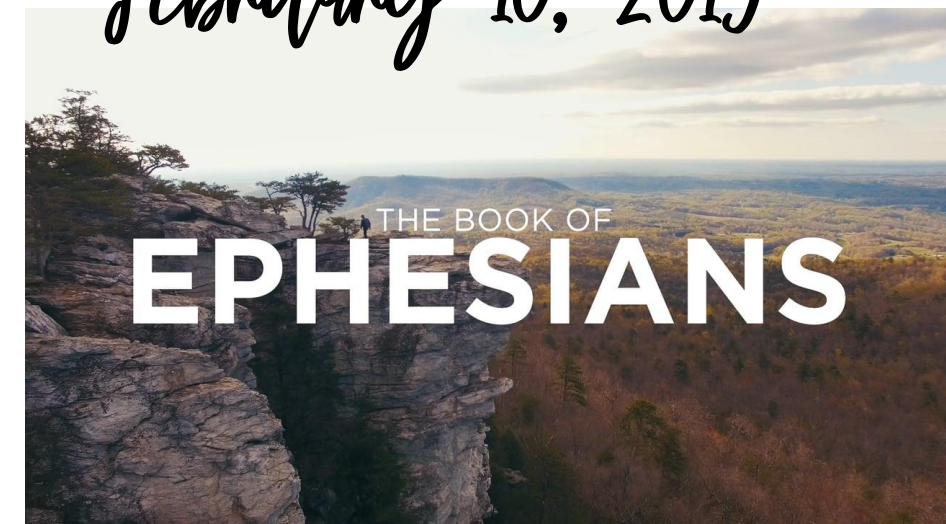
Library – Come and check out the NEW books.
